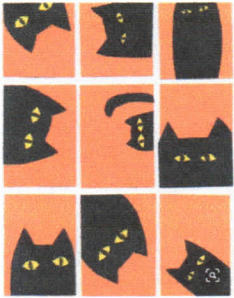


CLASSROOM UPDATES:
